

AMJ Theatrical Student Expectations

Updated April 2020

These rules have been devised to ensure all children have a fair and safe experience during AMJ Theatrical classes. AMJ Theatrical will ensure several verbal warnings are given during sessions to encourage any child to return their focus back to the session and re-engage with the group. If these warnings do not discourage unacceptable behaviour then we will have to issue a formal warning. If a child receives two formal warnings then we will issue a final written warning home, after which the next stage would be to remove the child from the group to ensure other children are receiving quality focused tuition.

Children are expected to demonstrate the following and ensure they show respect and support to the other children and teachers.

- Listen and demonstrate respectful behaviour when watching children perform.
- Interact considerately with other children during group games and work.
- Play fighting and running in the studio is strictly not allowed.
- AMJ Theatrical staff will communicate respectfully with all children and in return we expect the same respectful communication and behaviour towards staff.
- Mobile phones are not permitted in the studio and photo's are strictly forbidden of other students and staff.
- When dance and performance training is being taught, children should listen and raise their hand if they have any questions.
- AMJ Theatrical does not condone any use of bad or offensive language and has a zero tolerance of any form of bullying.

Above all, children should have fun, feel confident and take safe risks through Performing Arts training!

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
